

ENHANCING THE PERSONAL & PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT OF MACQUARIE STUDENTS


- Institution-wide program embedded in all Macquarie's bachelor degrees



- **community engagement**: mutually beneficial partnerships that helps partner achieve their mission and goals
- **rigorous academic framework** to develop key graduate capabilities



- PACE enthusiasts & Study Abroad and Exchange students (SAEX)


