



Here are some FAQs for ACSME 2016:

How many people are going to ACSME? We have over 110 presentations this year. The names on the mailing list constitute all the authors and co-authors who are represented at ACSME 2016.

Can I still submit? Unfortunately submissions for presentations have now closed. Speakers, poster presenters, and workshop presenters have been notified of acceptances.

When are the workshops – and what are the topics?

There are 17 workshops in all. You can register for the workshops by title using the website registration facility now. Don't worry about HAVING to do it now though, there will be more details soon and workshop registration will stay open until very close to the start of the conference.

When does registration close? EARLYBIRD registration closes on 5 August. Speaker spots for the conference will be confirmed at this time for registrants.

How do I know what date my talk or poster is on? All posters are officially presented on the first day of the conference, although you will be able to leave them up for the second day as well.

The full list of speakers will be uploaded to the conference website after the early bird registration deadline. Speaker spaces are contingent on registration by this date.

What if I don't register by the early-bird date?

You can still register after the early bird date but if you are a speaker, and you are not registered by 5 August, your speaking spot will be given to someone else and you will be able to present a poster. This is due to intense demand for speaker spots. Registered poster presenters may be offered a speaking opportunity if the currently assigned speakers are not registered by August 5th.
